

## Asbestos Awareness: 80803ACT Identification and Safe Handling of Asbestos

<p><b>COURSE OVERVIEW:</b></p>	<p>The aim of the course is to satisfy the regulatory requirements of the ACT Building Act. The course is designed to meet the needs of trades people, services workers, builders, building certifiers and community members.</p> <p>The Asbestos Awareness training is aimed at increasing employers and employees understanding of their duties and where there is cause for concern when it comes to asbestos in the workplace. Most people are emotive about asbestos and fail to understand that asbestos is a risk to health when asbestos fibres become airborne and are then inhaled.</p> <p>There is a general duty of care on employers to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all employees, visitors, contractors and others in the workplace. It is the employer's responsibility to ensure that all reasonably practicable measures have been taken to control risks against all possible injuries arising from asbestos in the workplace.</p> <p>One of the key elements of CTI's course is to explain how the law applies to asbestos and its management in the workplace. In other words how to comply with legislation to maintain a safe and healthy workplace.</p>
