COURSE OVERVIEW:	<p>This unit of competency specifies the outcomes required to work with or operate plant in or around close proximity of power sources, services and assets for the general safety of personnel and equipment. It includes all occupational areas that may require working near electricity.</p> <p>There is a general duty of care on employers to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all employees, visitors, contractors and others in the workplace. It is the employer's responsibility to ensure that all reasonably practicable measures have been taken to control risks against all possible injuries arising from working with (or near) electricity.</p>
OBJECTIVES:	<p>The main objectives of the course is to train participants about the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carry out legal requirements • Identify and control risk • Perform electric shock first aid • Understand signage • Identify sources of electric supply • Select approved cables and switches
