COURSE OVERVIEW:	<p>CTI's Height Safety Theory course meets the training and competency requirements as outlined in the Australian / New Zealand standard for industrial fall-arrest systems and devices (AS/NZS 1891.4:2009).</p> <p>This unit specifies the outcomes required to work safely on construction sites where work activity involves working above 1.5 metres from the ground level and where fall protection measures are required.</p> <p>There is a general duty of care on employers to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all employees, visitors, contractors and others in the workplace. It is the employer's responsibility to ensure that all reasonably practicable measures have been taken to control risks against all possible injuries arising from working at height.</p>
OBJECTIVES:	<p>The main objectives of the course is to train participants about the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carry out legal requirements • Identify and control risk • Identify, select and maintain height safety equipment • Effective use of height safety equipment • Knowledge of emergency procedures
