

National Construction Induction: CPCCOHS1001A Work Safely in the Construction Industry

COURSE OVERVIEW:	<p>National Construction Induction training (CPCCOHS1001A Work Safely in the Construction Industry) is a mandatory requirement under the law for all persons wishing to carry out construction type work. It allows persons doing the course to develop basic skills and knowledge in relation to risk management and relevant Workplace Health & Safety obligations and requirements.</p> <p>There is a general duty of care on employers to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all employees, visitors, contractors and others in the workplace. It is the employer's responsibility to ensure that all reasonably practicable measures have been taken to control risks against all possible injuries arising from working within the construction industry.</p>
OBJECTIVES:	<p>The main objectives of the course is to train participants about the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify hazards and assess risks • Identify hazardous materials and other hazards on work sites • Plan and prepare for safe work practices • Apply safe work practices • Follow emergency procedures
OUTCOMES:	<p>All course participants will receive information booklets to complement their understanding of the course matter and a Statement of Attainment will be issued on successful completion of the course, which will enable participants to commence work immediately. In addition, a 'white card' is produced and distributed by the Office of Regulatory Services within 10 working days.</p>
PRE-REQUISITES:	<p>There are no entry requirements for this course.</p>
